- **Breast surgery,** including breast biopsy, breast-conserving surgery, mastectomy, nipple-sparing mastectomy and coordination with plastic surgeons for oncoplastic breast surgery and reconstruction
- **Endocrine surgery** for thyroid, parathyroid, pancreatic and adrenal disorders
- **Esophageal surgery** for achalasia, Barrett's esophagus, esophageal cancer and GERD with the new North Memorial Esophageal Center
- Gastrointestinal/abdominal surgery, including cholecystectomy, feeding tubes, gastric resections, small bowel resections, colon resections, appendectomy and colostomy reversal
- **Hernia surgery,** minimally invasive and open repair of the following hernias: hiatal/paraesophageal, diaphragmatic, umbilical, inguinal, complex ventral and incisional
- **Oncologic surgery** for cancer of the breast, colon, esophagus, gallbladder, liver, pancreas, skin, small intestine, spleen, stomach and thyroid, as well as lymph node biopsy and infusion port placement
- **Skin and soft tissue surgery** for excision of skin and soft tissue masses and cancers, pilonidal disease, temporal artery biopsy and foreign body removal
- **Weight loss surgery,** including gastric sleeve and Roux en Y gastric bypass
- **Endoscopy,** including screening and diagnostic colonoscopies, upper endoscopies and PEG tube placement
